#### **Guest Speakers**

# 1. Nikki Barker, BRANCH.

Nikki shared details of BRANCH which included;

- BRANCH is an online mental wellbeing hub, run by different organisations across
  Wirral, in partnership with Wirral Metropolitan Borough Council and NHS
  Cheshire and Merseyside ICB, for children and young people from 0 to 18 (and up
  to 25 with additional needs), helping to find the best tools and local support.
  Under 13's can access with support from parent/carer/guardian/trusted adult.
- BRANCH is now the central point of access for My Mind Wirral CYPMHS (was CAMHS).
- It can be used for/by any child or young person who is registered with a Wirral GP, no matter how big or small their worries feel. It's packed with tips to help them feel better and, when they need a bit of extra support, gives simple routes into local services.
- Branch doesn't offer crisis support but has information on where to get help in an emergency.
- Dashboard for ease of use, with a questionnaire that matches the best services available for each individual.



#### 2. Paul Ariss, Cheshire & Merseyside Cancer Alliance.

Paul shared details of the Cheshire & Merseyside Cancer Alliance - how he has been working as part of an NHS England Cancer Experience of Care Improvement Collaborative, and part of this has been working on increasing awareness for the long standing and ongoing **Quality of Life survey**, which is shared to patients 18 months after their cancer diagnosis.

- The survey helps people to share their experiences
- Will help to improve pathways and offer better care

The survey uptake figures for Wirral are slightly below national target and Paul asks that all share to help reach as many Wirral participants as possible.

# 3. Christopher Puddephatt, Spider Project. SILK Family and Carer Support Worker.

Chris shared details of Spider Project's SILK support, which offers one-to-one and group work, creative recovery courses and telephone support for anyone who is a Carer/ parent/ friend of someone with substance misuse issues.

- Peer support groups with families, Carers, friends.
- A wide range of activities are available; pottery, painting, drama, holistic therapies, music, photography, as well as creative recovery courses and more.
- They run a Ketamine peer support group.
